### Outstanding Features:

- Offices are situated around a  
seven-story, 30,000 square foot  
atrium, where employees and  
guests can enjoy the natural  
daylight from the skylight
- Two 80-foot high basket handles  
are attached to the building with  
replica copper and wooden rivets  
and are heated to prevent ice from forming
- Bassatt and Associates coordinated landscaping design and installation with an  
exclusive design that is fully irrigated
- 142-seat theater style auditorium on the first floor
- Two Longaberger 750-pound, 23 karat gold plated tags are attached to both sides  
of the building. The tags are 25 feet x 7 feet x 3 feet

### Points of Interest:

- Longaberger managed the entire project and  
Longaberger personnel constructed over 50% of  
the building
- Completion of building and move in for  
employees was December, 1997
- The company designed the exterior and interior  
of the building
- NBBJ and Korda Nemeth Engineering  
administered design process
- Addition of facility in Newark area added 500 jobs  
in addition to generating additional tax revenue benefiting Licking County school  
systems, local organizations and the community as a whole
